



Kepler Astrophysical Positional Probabilities Table Delivery Log

2015-07-16	Initial release of the Kepler astrophysical positional probabilities table. This table contains an entry for all objects in the Kepler Q1-Q17 DR24 KOI table, and provides information about the probability that the transit source is in the same position as the target star or other known star. See KSCI-19092 for details.
2015-11-10	Update to fix a software bug. As a result of this change, for targets with host probability score > 0.3 , 231 targets' host probabilities changed by more than 1%, of which 68 changed by more than 10%. Host probabilities are generally unreliable when the host probability score is < 0.3 .
2016-01-21	Update to incorporate the Q1–Q17 DR24 ephemeris match results. The impact is that 325 KOIs, all of which are dispositioned in the Q1–Q17 DR24 KOI table as FALSE POSITIVE, are now marked as MATCH in the Host Star Relative Probability Source Flag column. No changes were made to the associated APP reports for the individual objects.
